

What do practitioners need in collaborative practice?

I think ethics are so foundational to any kind of participatory and collaborative practice because from the question of ethics and consent fly out all these different questions that have to be at the core of what we're doing. In my work at *Photovoice*, often we were working with teams of photographers and teams of facilitators, and people come off into these projects with very clear ideas about how they might go about what they do, and as soon as you're involved in those relationships and people you're working with stuff comes up all the time. You find you're constantly questioning yourself. And in terms of all the support that we need as practitioners, that a space and encounters where you can just stop, discuss some of those things, without the feeling that there are definitive answers - and you've got to find those definitive answers - but just places we can have those conversations is really vital to all of us being able to think these things through.
